



EXPANDED DUTY CARE

Do you need help with additional child care beyond regular child care hours?

Free child care is provided for parents who must work beyond their normal duty schedule, for exercises, nights, weekends, etc.

The Expanded Duty Care (EDC) Program assists military families working expanded duty hours. Care is provided in Air Force licensed Family Child Care (FCC) homes.

This program provides services beyond the standard 50 hours of care that families are already using in the child care centers on and off base.

The program is available for:

- **On-base Mission Related Duty**
- **Expanded Duty Days**
- **Temporary Shift Changes**
- **Rapid Mobilization**
- **Deployment**

The EDC program is not to be used on a regular basis.

The EDC program is closed during the 2 weeks of the Christmas Holiday Season (usually the last 2 weeks in Dec).

VERIFICATION: Member's eligibility to use free care will be verified by the FCC Office prior to reserving care.
