- Retest waiting period due to failure (unless otherwise stated by testing agency): CLEP 3 months; DSST 90 days
- One free score report will be sent to the institution of your choice. Official transcripts can be ordered later for a fee.
- AF members: When registering for exams, be sure to use your SSN and choose "AIR FORCE" as your branch of service to have your scores automatically sent to Community College of the Air Force (CCAF).
