





Scholarships launch

The Air & Space Forces Association (previously known as the Air Force Association) is now accepting applications to all of its scholarship programs!

In 2022, AFA contributed more than \$230,000 to Airmen, Guardians, their spouses, and their children through 12 unique scholarships. The scholarships help fund college tuition, flight school, dental school, Arnold Air Society and Silver Wings, and even full rides to certain universities.

The deadline for all scholarship applications listed below is April 30, 2023, 11:59pm EDT. Interested candidates may apply online at www.afa.org/scholarships.

Col Aaron Burgstein Memorial Scholarship

Provides \$1,000 annually to minor dependents of Active, Guard, Reserve, veteran, or retired members of any service branch pursuing a degree at an accredited college or university.

Capt Jodi Callahan Memorial Scholarship

Provides \$2,000 to USAF/USSF Active Duty or fulltime Guard or Reserve personnel pursuing a master's degree in a non-technical field.

Mike and Gail Donley Spouse Scholarship Provides \$2,500 annually to encourage Air Force or Space Force spouses worldwide to pursue higher education.

Lt Col Romeo and Bass Ferretti Scholarship

Provides \$5,000 to minor dependents of Air Force Active Duty, Reserve, or Air National Guard enlisted Airmen pursuing an undergraduate STEM degree.

Col Loren J. and Lawona R. Spencer Scholarship Provides three \$5,000 scholarships for Air Force or Space Force personnel (Active Duty, civilian, or fulltime National Guard or Reserve) to pursue graduate-level education in management and administration in preparation for senior-level leadership roles.

John C. and Blanche L. Lindsay Memorial Scholarship Provides one \$2,500 scholarship to a child of members of the United States Air and Space Forces who is pursuing a college degree.

Dr. Sydell Perlmutter Gold Memorial ScholarshipProvides a renewable \$5,000 annual scholarship (for a total possible award of \$20,000) to the daughter of Active, Guard, or Reserve Air Force or Space Force members pursuing a bachelor's degree in a STEM field.

Delta Dental Grants

Provides five \$2,000 scholarships and grants to military spouses, military dependents, and transitioning

service members for the advancement of oral health and wellness.

Trident University Full Scholarship

Provides full-tuition scholarships to current AFA members pursuing bachelor's or master's degrees at Trident University. Both current and prospective students are eligible.

Tuskegee Airmen Memorial Scholarship

Provides \$1,000 to current and former members of the Air and Space Forces, Air National Guard, and Reserve, and their spouses and children to pursue a college degree or flight training.

Destin Flight Works Pilot Training Scholarship Funded by Vertol Systems Company, Inc., this program provides one AFA member per year up to \$10,000 toward pilot training courses, instructor fees, and aircraft rental, leading to a private pilot's license at the Destin Flight Works school in Destin, Florida.

General Henry H. Arnold Education Grant

Applications for the 2023-2024 academic year are now available through April 30, 2023.

The General Henry H. Arnold Education Grant program, also known as the Hap Arnold Grant, is the centerpiece of Air Force Aid Society (AFAS) education support. The application process for the Arnold Education Grant serves as the platform for other key education support opportunities at the Society.

The Hap Arnold Grant is competitive in its needbased selection criteria and is uniquely tailored to recognize the proper weighing of family income and education costs.

Grants ranging from \$500 to \$2,000 are awarded to eligible Air Force and Space Force dependents each year. The specific amount awarded correlates to a student's particular level of financial need.


