- Two letters of recommendation

The deadline for submitting completed applications and supporting materials to your high school counselor is April 18.

NC Opportunity Scholarships

The Opportunity Scholarship program was created by the North Carolina General Assembly in 2013. Scholarships are awarded based on a family's household income and can be used to pay the required tuition and fees to attend an eligible private school.

Parents of any NC school student entering kindergarten through 12th grade may apply. Scholarships range from approximately \$3,000 to \$7,000. The application period is Feb 1—March 1.



Reimbursement for state re-licensure, re-certification and small business costs of dependent spouses

There has been a lot of talk recently about the Spouse Licensure Portability legistation. "In addition to that, there is a Spouse licensure reimbursement program that has been active since 2017 and has recently been amended to include costs associated with relocating a small business," says Jeff Craver, Military & Family Readiness Center flight chief. Below are the highlights, local process to submit a claim.

- These benefits provide spouses of Airmen or Guardians who PCS or PCA the opportunity to recoup up to \$1,000 for re-licensing, re-certification, and/or small business costs.
- This is a Total Force benefit, so any regular Air Force, Space Force, Air Force Reserve, or Air National Guard members with qualifying PCS/PCS orders may be eligible, providing the situation meets the criteria established in the policy.
- Licensure and small business claims are distinct, and a member can file a claim for both, if all eligibility criteria are met.
- Policy for this program is in DAFMAN 36-2012.

Below is the process here locally, per SSgt Joseph Violette, 4th Comptroller Squadron:

Spouse Re-licensure/Re-certification are reimbursed to the military member via OF 1164. The member requests this reimbursement by sending an email to our FMA Org box (4cpts.fma@us.af.mil). Required documents to process this claim are:

- 1. PCS/ PCA orders
 - Must be filed within 24 months of authentication
 - Must have movement of dependent at government expense
 - Not authorized upon Accession, Career Intermission Program, Ret. or Sep.
- 2. Previous State's Licenses/ Certificates
 - Prior State License or Certificate (must match location where they are traveling from)
- 3. New State's Licenses/ Certificates
 - New License must be for previous occupation (Nurse to Nurse) not (Lawyer to Nurse)
- 4. Receipts for Reimbursement
 - Reimbursement will not exceed \$1000; exam and registration fees are reimbursable.







Military life can make for tricky taxes. To help, the Defense Department offers MilTax software through Military OneSource. It's built to account for deployments, combat and training pay, housing and rentals, multistate filings, living OCONUS and more.

Eligible servicemembers and spouses can file federal and up to three state tax returns and get expert tax support—all at no cost.




