GUEST RESPONSIBILITIES

As a guest, you are responsible for —

- Your conduct and that of your guests and family members, while in government lodging.
- Children under the age of 12 years must have adult supervision at all times. Parents should not allow children to jump on the beds or play in the windowsill.
- Conservation of utilities and compliance with Fire, Health, and Safety regulations.
- Reimbursement to lodging for damage beyond fair, wear and tear, and missing government property caused by abuse or negligence on your part or by your guest. Rearrangement of room furnishings is not permitted.
- Ensuring the room is kept neat and orderly at all times, cleaning the kitchenette area, refrigerator, stove, and dishes during your stay at the Southern Pines Inn.
- Report maintenance problems to the front desk or complete a maintenance request form.

SMOKING POLICY — All of our facilities are non-smoking. The designated smoking areas are marked near each building. If a guest is found smoking in a room, the guest may be charged a \$150.00 service fee in addition to normal room charges.

EXCESS CLEANING CHARGES — Additional cleaning fees may be charged upon management's request. The guest will be notified with explanation and fees.

UNAUTHORIZED PET IN ROOM — Minimum \$150.00 for deep cleaning services and a \$10.00 per night pet fee for entire stay in room.

GENERAL INFORMATION

CHECK-IN/OUT TIME — Check-in time is 1400 hours or upon availability of room. Checkout time is at 1100 hours. If you check out after 1100 hours, you may be charged for an additional night.

EMERGENCY SHELTER — In the event of a hurricane or tornado, please go to the first floor hallway of your building. Stay away from glass doors and windows.

FAX SERVICE — Facsimile is available for official government business only; see front desk personnel for assistance. Our fax number is DSN: 722-0375 and Com: 919-722-0375.

FIRE/GROUND SAFETY — Please avoid the following hazards:

1. Smoking in facilities is prohibited.
2. Storing highly flammable liquids/materials in your room
3. Using unauthorized cooking or heating devices in your room
4. Placing charcoal grills within 15 feet of the building
5. Placing hot appliances in lockers, drawers or on beds
6. Overloading electrical circuits; use of multiple plugs is unauthorized
7. Leaving electrical appliances on when you leave the room
8. Leaving cooking equipment unattended
9. Candles or incense are not authorized

HOUSEKEEPING — Housekeeping service is provided seven days a week unless a “Do Not Disturb (DND)” sign is displayed. Housekeeping is required to enter the room after three consecutive days of DND. Pet Friendly rooms must be serviced daily (see Pet Agreement). Light Service (beds made, floors and toilets cleaned, and waste baskets emptied) will be provided daily for our Stay Over Guests. Extended Stay Overs (guest who are with us for over seven days) will receive Full Service. On top of the daily service, this will also include bedding changed, dusting and tubs and sinks cleaned thoroughly. As a reminder our housekeeping staff is not authorized to touch a guest’s personal items.

MAINTENANCE — If you should have a maintenance problem with your room, please call the front desk or complete the maintenance form in your room and forward it to housekeeping.

MOVING TRUCKS — Moving trucks or oversized vehicles are not allowed in the lodging parking lot. They must be parked in the parking lot at Davis Hall (building 3815) with a Southern Pines Inn Trailer Parking Pass. For more information (or to obtain a pass), please contact the front desk.

PCS GUESTS — PCS guests are authorized 30 days (if available) in government quarters. If a PCS guest needs additional days in the room, they must contact the front desk for an extension at least seven days prior to the departure date.

PERSONAL PROPERTY — Personal property should be locked in your luggage or taken with you when you leave your room. Housekeepers are instructed not to pick up or move your personal property at any time. Leaving items lying around the room may result in your quarters not being properly cleaned. Your assistance in keeping your room orderly is greatly appreciated.

“DO NOT DISTURB” SIGNS — If you do not want housekeeping services in the morning, please place the “Do Not Disturb” sign on the doorknob to your room. For the safety and welfare of our guests, after a “Do Not Disturb” sign has been posted for 72 consecutive hours, the housekeeping staff is required to enter the guest’s room. **Pet Friendly Rooms will be serviced every day regardless if there is a sign on the door.**

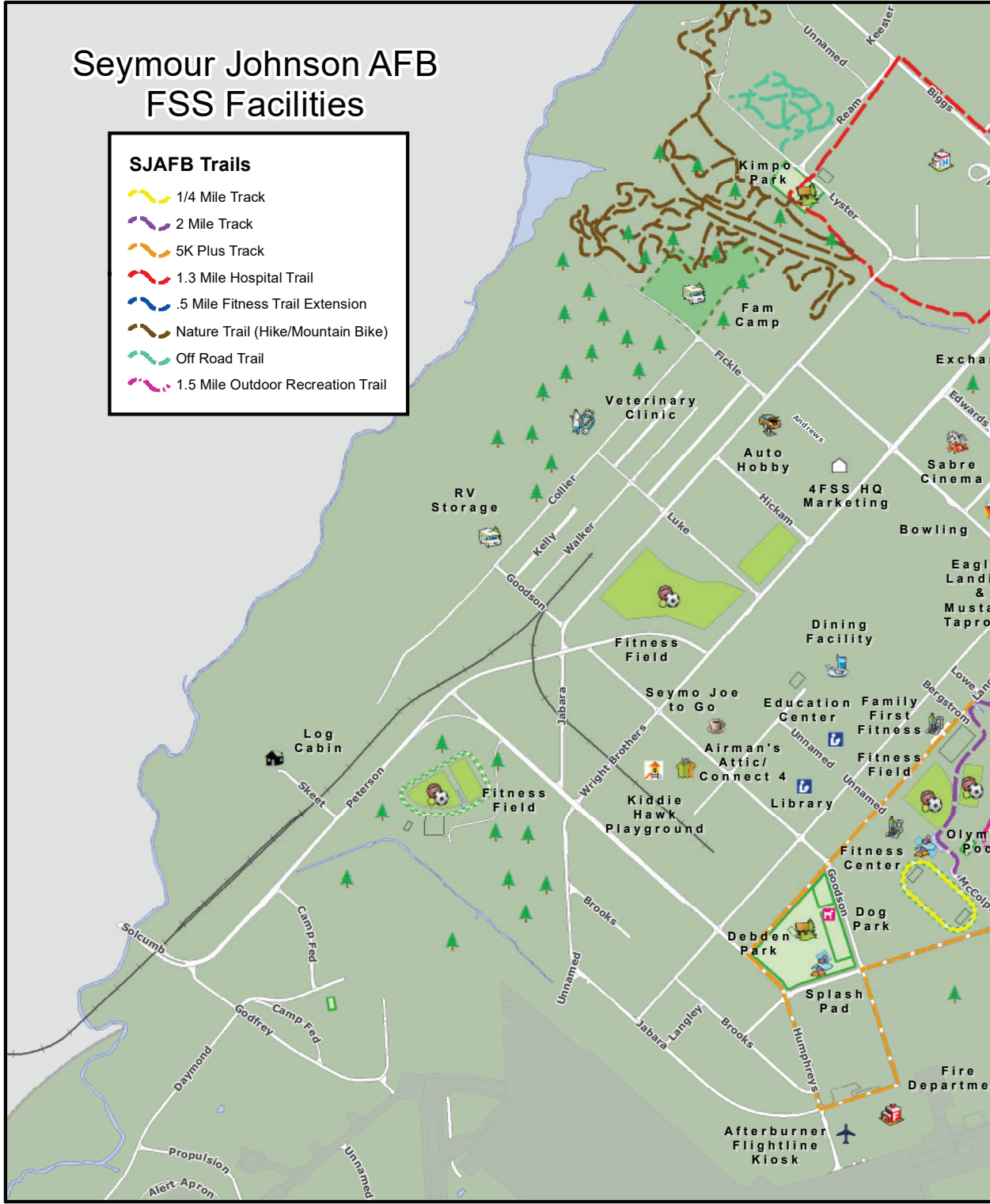

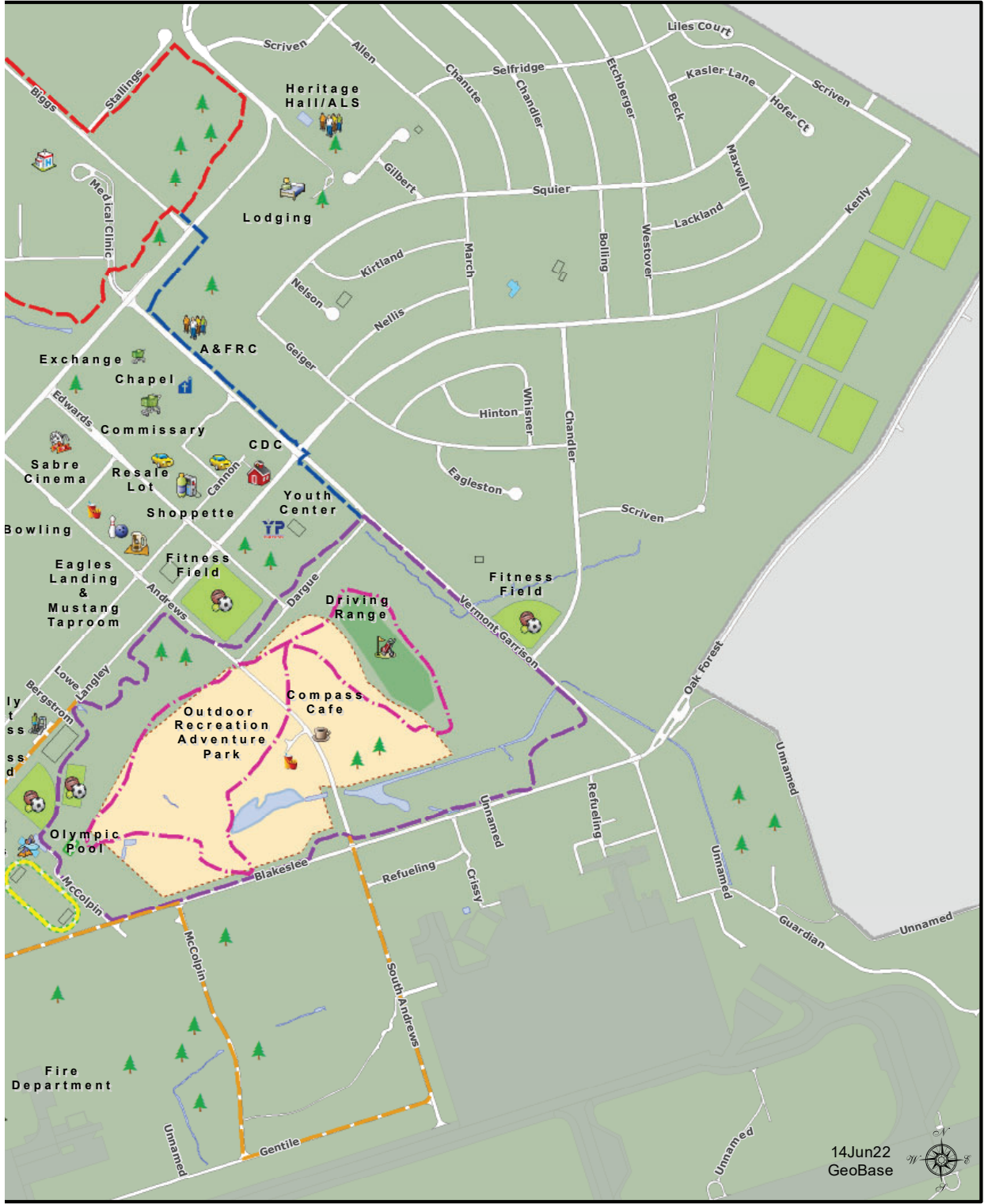

4th FIGHTER WING HISTORY

The 4th Fighter Wing traces its ancestry back to the Royal Air Force Eagle Squadrons when American volunteers flew Hurricanes and Spitfires in England prior to the entry of the United States into World War II. When the United States entered the war in 1942, the three Eagle Squadrons converted to the US Army Air Corps 334th, 335th and 336th Fighter Squadrons and combined to form the 4th Fighter Group, an integral part of the 8th Air Force. The 4th Fighter Group destroyed 1,016 enemy aircraft, more than any other group in World War II.

During the Korean conflict, the 4th Fighter Interceptor Wing was the first to fly the F-86 in combat. The Wing had the most kills: 506 aircraft or 54% of the total. In Vietnam, the 4th was the first wing from Tactical Air Command to augment the Pacific Air Forces,

flying more than 8,700 combat missions in that theater.

In 1990, the 335th and 336th Tactical Fighter Squadrons were the first operational units to respond to Iraq's invasion of Kuwait. In DESERT SHIELD and DESERT STORM aircrews of the 4th Fighter Wing flew over 3,200 sorties, dropped over 5,000 tons of ordnance and 27% of all the laser guided bombs employed during the conflict.

After the Gulf War, the 4th maintained a near constant presence in Southwest Asia supporting Operations NORTHERN WATCH, SOUTHERN WATCH, and ALLIED FORCE. Post DESERT STORM, the 4th Fighter Wing flew over 15,000 sorties in Northern and Southern Iraq, delivering over 240 tons of precision and nonprecision weapons in response to Iraqi violations of United Nations'

mandates.

In 2001, the 4th Fighter Wing was called to defend the nation's airspace in what later became Operation NOBLE EAGLE. The 335th Fighter Squadron deployed overseas, flying critical missions in support of anti-terrorist actions such as Operation ANACONDA where they dropped over 60 tons of ordnance. The wing was also responsible for the buildup of a coalition operations base in the former Soviet Union.

During January 2003, the 4th Fighter Wing deployed two F-15E squadrons to Southwest

Asia in support of Operation SOUTHERN WATCH, which later transitioned to Operation IRAQI FREEDOM. By April 2003, as a part of the 379th Air Expeditionary Wing, members of the 4th Fighter Wing flew over 3,500 missions, dropping over 3 million pounds of ordnance.

In September 2007 the 336th Fighter Squadron deployed to Bagram Air Base, Afghanistan, to provide the air power needed to fight Operation ENDURING FREEDOM. In January 2008 the 335th Fighter Squadron deployed to continue the OEF mission. Overcoming tremendous obstacles, including

a determined enemy, harsh climate and mountainous terrain, both squadrons performed magnificently. The 336th FS flew over 5,700 combat hours with over 1,300 combat sorties that included 36 Alert Launches and 343 Troops in Contact missions. The 335th FS flew over 4,300 combat hours with over 1,200 combat sorties that included 24 Alert Launches and 187 Troops in Contact missions. These deployments greatly enhanced the already remarkable history of the 4th Fighter Wing.

Today, members of the 4th Fighter Wing continue to have a presence in the Middle East supporting the war against ter-

ror and the ongoing conflict in Afghanistan. In addition to the fighter squadron deployments, almost all 4th Fighter Wing Airmen and some civilians deploy all over the world to support the needs of the Air Force. In the past, present and future, the men and women of this great Wing are the tip of the spear confronting the enemies of our nation.

Decorations earned by the 4th Fighter Wing include three distinguished unit citations, two Republic of Korea unit citations and 13 Air Force Outstanding Unit awards. The “Fourth But First” is proud of its long history of dedicated service.
