The Air Force Services Center (AFSVC) presents the Air Force Art Contest for ages 6 through adult, novice to accomplished. Winners are determined by a panel of qualified judges. Judging is based on impact, creativity, and technical expertise. Prizes are awarded to the top three in each of the five categories.

This year there are two types of art competitions: 2D Art and 3D Art. 2D Art is considered to be two-dimensional, such as a drawing, sketch, or painting. Accepted media include oil, watercolor, acrylic, pastel, mixed media, gouache, egg tempera, pen and ink, charcoal, colored pencil, scratch board, markers and metal point (no digital art). 3D Art is considered to be three-dimensional, such as, sculpture, ceramic, pottery, clay, glass art, metals, jewelry, wood, fiber, and textile.

Artists may submit up to two uploaded photographs of their 2D and/or 3D art entries per competition. The subject of the artwork is at the discretion of the artist but must be in compliance with the Official Rules of the contest.





*Healthy Hustle* - Provides guided run workouts to train on cardio endurance, proper running form and meet cardio standards for DAF PT assessments.


Sweatmasters - Provides a high intensity interval training that will challenge your cardivascular endurance and strength designed for meeting DAF PT assessments.
