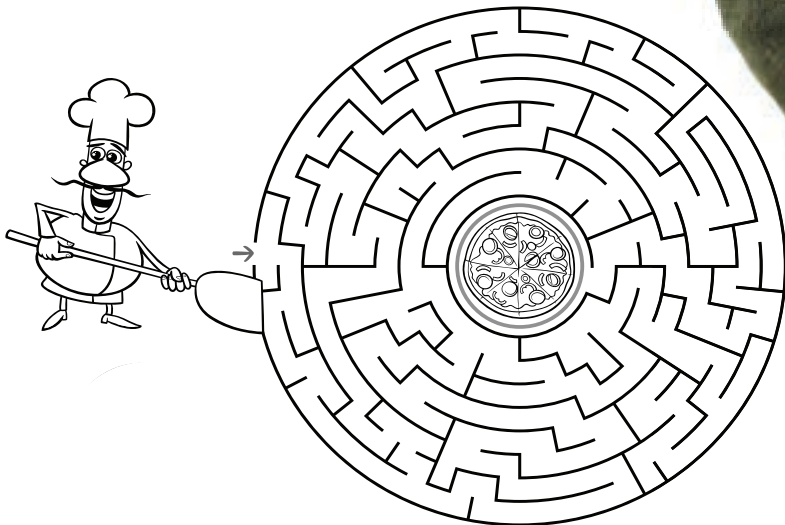

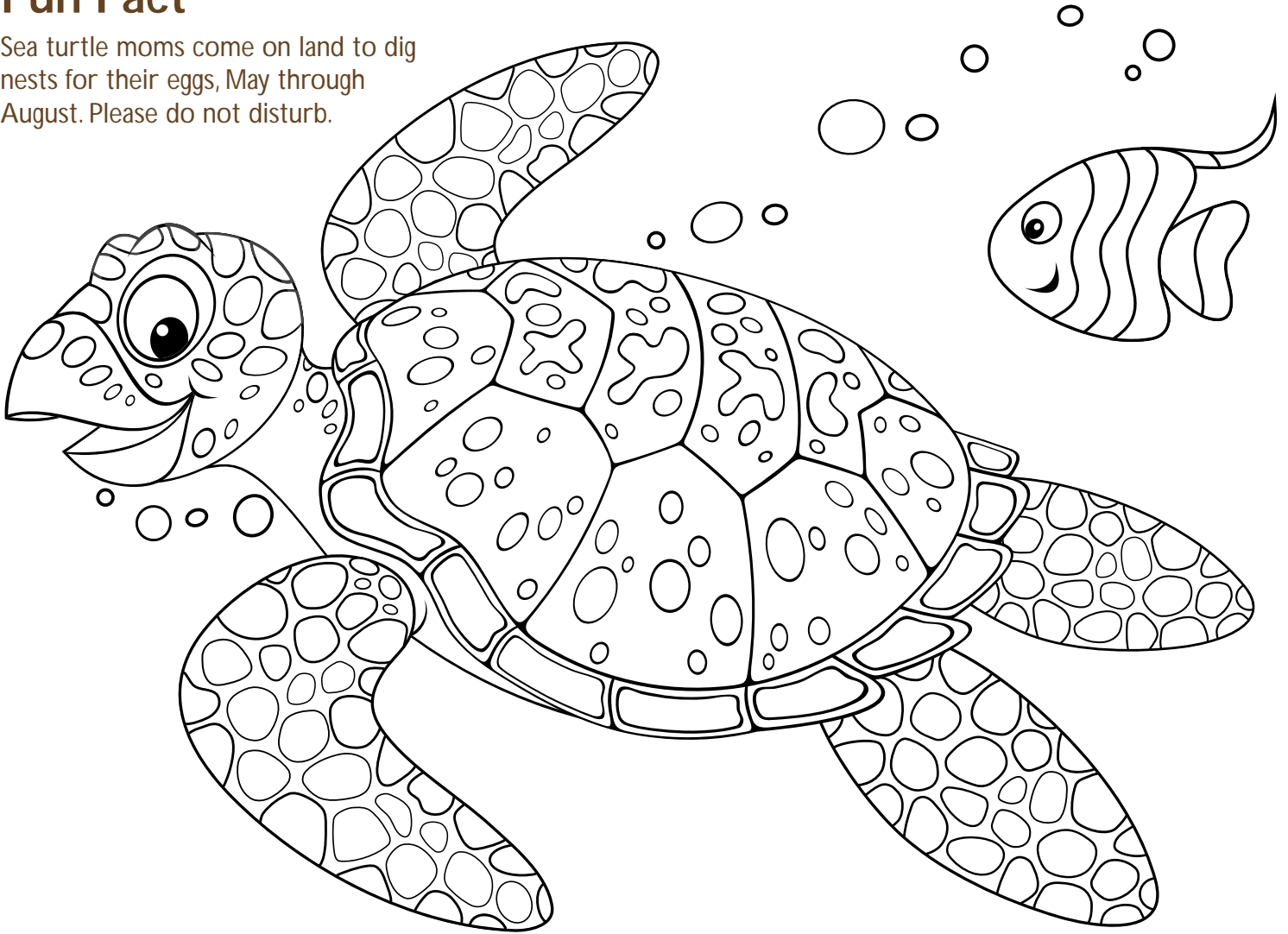

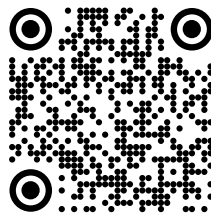

The Air Force Aid Society (AFAS) recognizes that Air Force families are subject to unique stresses due to the nature of military life—deployments, remote tours, extended working hours, etc. Families are often separated from spouses as well as from extended family members who might otherwise offer support. In an effort to help these families, the AFAS in cooperation with the Air Force child care community, has agreed to provide funding for childcare under the program called Give Parents a Break (GPAB).

The purpose of this program is to offer eligible parents of children ages 6 weeks-12 years, a few hours break from the stresses of parenting. Eligible families must be referred by one of the following: Squadron Commander, First Sergeant, Chaplain, Family Advocacy, Airman and Family Readiness Center, Child Development Center and Youth Center. If childcare is needed but you do not qualify for GPAB, you may sign up and pay the hourly rate of \$7 per child.

Registration begins two weeks prior and ends the Wednesday before the date listed. Some restrictions and requirements apply; see the CDC or Youth Center for more details.

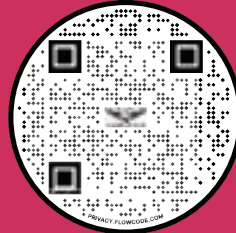

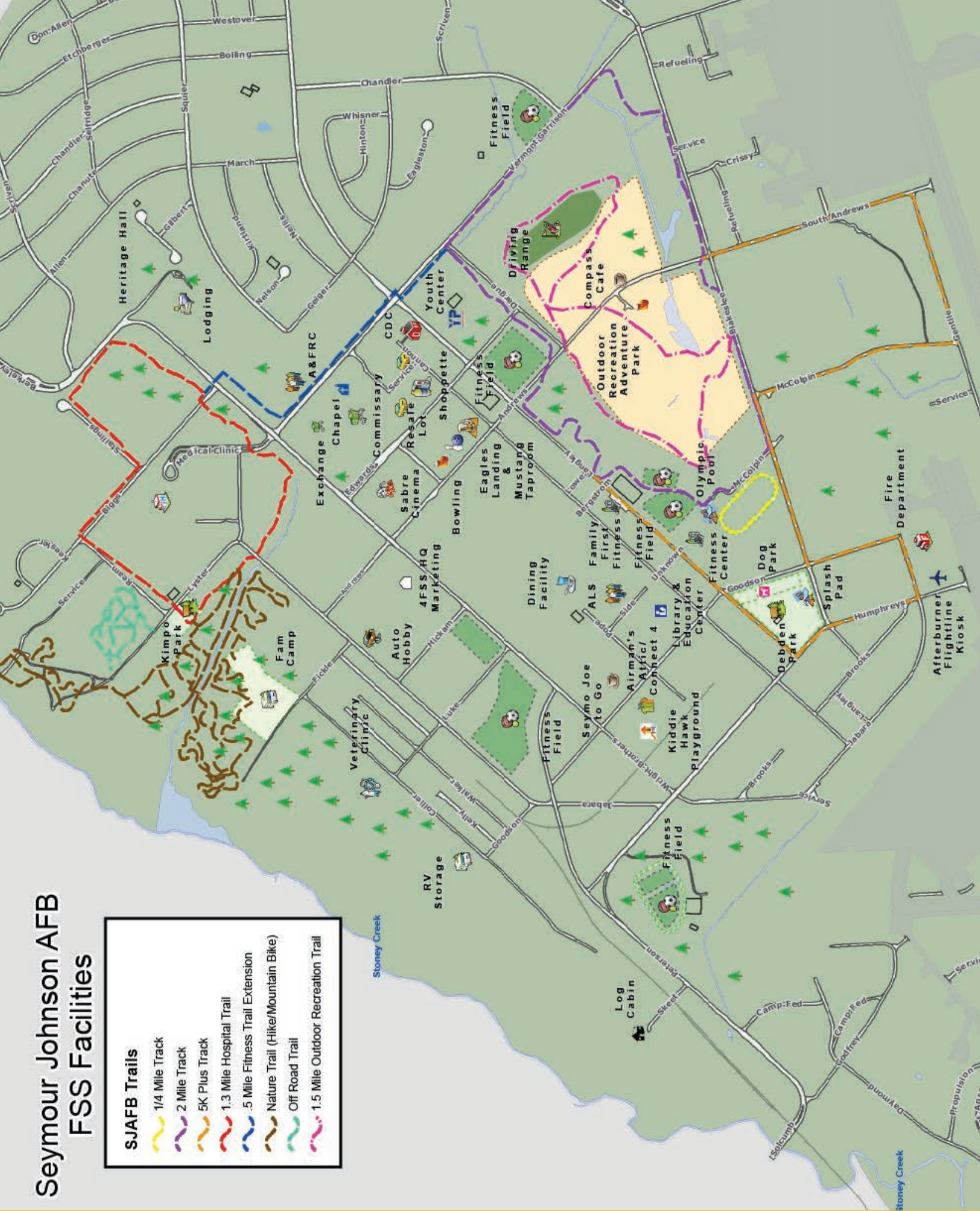
