The Air Force Aid Society (AFAS) in cooperation with the Air Force child care community, provides funding for childcare under the Give Parents a Break (GPAB) program.

This program offers eligible parents of children ages 6 weeks-12 years, a few hours break from the stresses of parenting. Eligible families must be referred by one of the following: Squadron Commander, First Sergeant, Chaplain, Family Advocacy, Airman and Family Readiness Center, Child Development Center and Youth Center.

If childcare is needed but you do not qualify for GPAB, you may sign up and pay the hourly rate of \$7 per child.

Registration begins two weeks prior and ends the Wednesday before the date listed.

The Seymour Johnson Exchange is waiving its layaway service fee of \$3 on toys, bikes, computers, laptops, tablets, iPads, notebooks, smartwatches and more when layaways are paid in full and picked up by close of business on Dec. 24.






