

- WHAT'S NEW -

To improve inclusivity and alignment in current operating environments of Department of the Air Force (DAF) delivered family readiness services, former Airman & Family Readiness Centers (A&FRCs) are hereby renamed to Military & Family Readiness Centers (M&FRCs).

— MOVING FORWARD —

Effective 3 September, the Family First Fitness (3F) facility will undergo renovations and transition as the new M&FRC location. 3F will permanently close, however the Parent Child Area equipment currently located in the 3F facility will be relocated to the main Fitness Center. Massage services will move to Connect 4 effective 5 September.

While construction is underway, the M&FRC will continue providing worldclass services supporting resilience and readiness from its present location on Vermont Garrison Street. Updates to the timeline will be shared via e-mail, the FSS website and social media as progress is made.

Please excuse any inconvenience as we work to improve our readiness support to the base community.

— for Active Duty member experiencing an emergency medical issue with an immediate family member

EXTENDED DUTY CARE

— when weekly workloads exceed their typical 50-hour child care arrangements on a temporary basis

HOME COMMUNITY CARE

— for members of the Guard or Reserves during their regularly scheduled drill periods (training or UTAs)

MILITARY SPOUSE APPOINTMENT CARE

— child care during medical appointments, M&FRC classes, Chaplain or Family Advocacy appointments, job interviews, etc.

NEW PROVIDER'S ORIENTATION CARE

 child care for Family Child Care provider applicants to attend FCC Provider Orientation classes

short term child care when a Wounded Warrior has medical or military appointments




