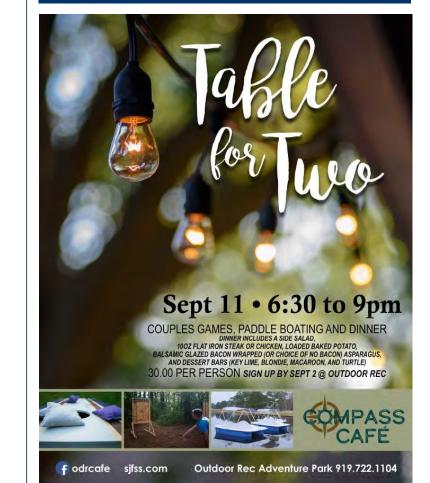

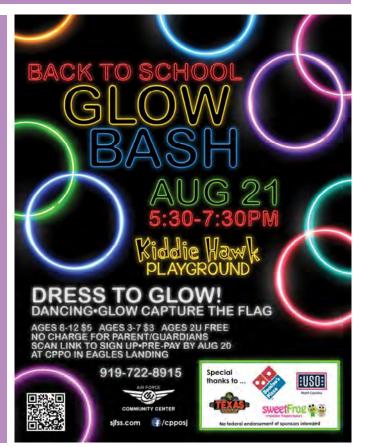

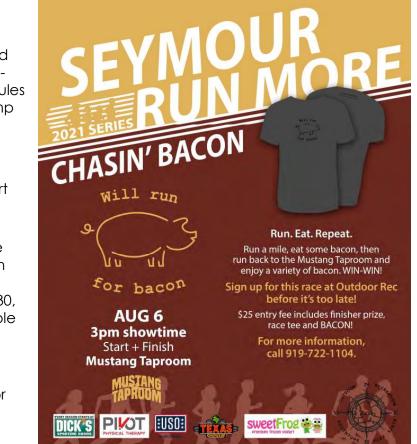

Exchange extends layaway to include Back-to-School Electronics Essentials

The Seymour Johnson Exchange is showing Air Force families that it matters where they shop, allowing more time to pay for electronics during back-to-school season.

Now through Sept. 2, Army & Air Force Exchange Service shoppers can use layaway to hold tax-free purchases of computers, notebooks, tablets and iPads—items that are not typically eligible for the program.

"Technology is evolving quickly and having the right tablet or computer can be critical to academic achievement," said Seymour Johnson Exchange store manager Rudy Gallardo. "The Exchange's layaway program is an affordable, practical way for students to stay on top of their studies."

A \$3 service fee and a deposit of 15% are required to hold items on layaway. Items must be picked up by Sept. 2. Shoppers can visit customer service at the Seymour Johnson Exchange for details.

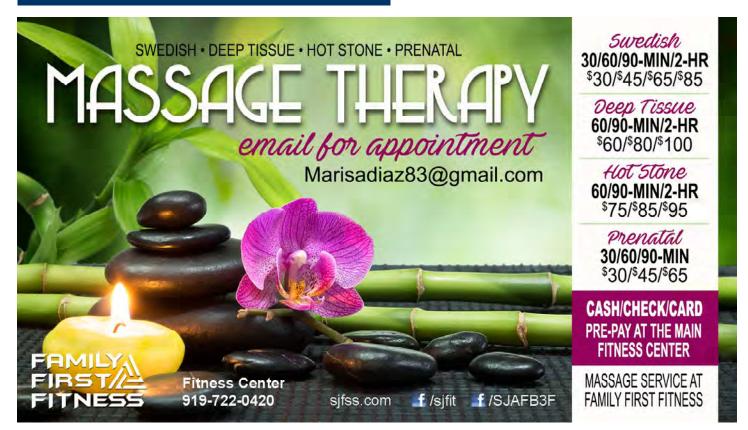
Wild Horses & Lighthouse Tour

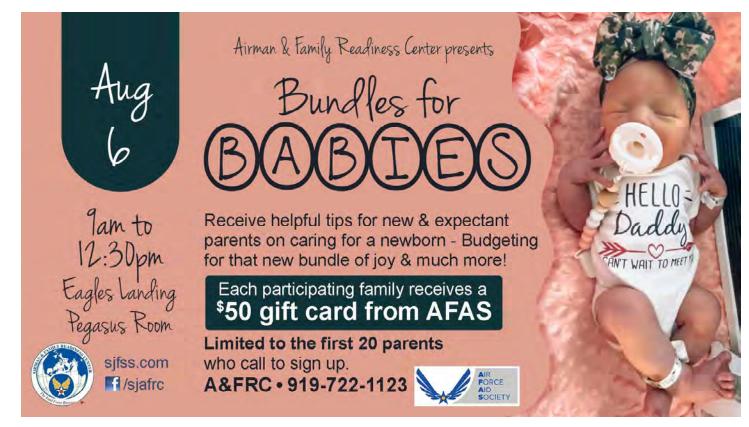
