

Information about FCC

Mission Statement: To assist DoD military and civilian personnel in balancing the competing demands of the accomplishment of the DoD mission and family life by managing and delivery a system of quality, available, and affordable programs and services for eligible children and youth birth through 18 years of age.

Seymour Johnson FCC Program offers quality child care in nurturing and supportive home environments for military children ages 2 weeks - 12 years old.

All providers meet DoD, AF and SJAFB requirements. All providers are monitored and observed at least monthly to ensure compliance with fire, safety, health, and developmentally appropriate practices. FCC providers are private business owners, and while AF has oversight, the AF does not dictate the provider's professional business practices.

All providers residing on the installation are certified by the Mission Support Group Commander to provide child care in their homes. Affiliated providers residing off the installation must receive state licensing prior to receiving affiliation by the Mission Support Group Commander.

ENROLL IN FCC

Step 1: Go to www.MilitaryChildCare.com and create an account.

Step 2: Search the system for the child care options that best fit your needs and submit your request for care.

Step 3: Manage your requests for care from anywhere in the world.

Step 4: Keep your *My Profile* page up-to-date.

AF FCC SUBSIDY

The AF FCC Subsidy is designed to assist your family's utilization of a FCC home and to pay the same weekly fee you would be charged for child care in an AF Child Development Center or AF School-Age Care program when space in those programs is not available.

Children must be enrolled in FCC from the MilitaryChildCare.com waitlist to be eligible.

UNAUTHORIZED CHILD CARE

It is in violation of AFI 34-144, *Child and Youth Programs*, for anyone residing in base privatized housing to provide child care services on a regular basis for 10 or more hours per week.

AIR FORCE FUNDED EXPANDED CHILD CARE (ECC) PROGRAMS

EXTENDED DUTY CARE (EDC) - When you are required to work in support of the 4 FW mission, exceeding the normal operating hours of the facility in which you purchase full-time care. Examples: temporary shift change, federal holidays, installation down days, etc.

SUPPLEMENTAL CARE (SCC 24/7) - When your work schedule is outside the normal operating hours of the facility where you already purchase full-time care.

DEPLOYMENT CARE (DCC) - When the military member is deployed in support of contingency operations for more than 30 days, you can receive 16 hours of child care, per child, per month. Eligibility includes 30 days prior to deployment and 60 days from returning home.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE (EMC) - To assist you if there is a medical situation with an immediate family member.

MILITARY SPOUSE APPOINTMENT CARE (MSAC) - Will cover child care for spouse medical appointments, job interviews, AFRC workshops, Key Spouse Initial Training, etc.

WOUNDED WARRIOR CARE - For when the Wounded Warrior has medical and/or military appointments.

CHILD CARE FOR FALLEN WARRIORS - If you have a fallen military family member and require hourly child care for appointments.

ECC, CONTINUED

HOME COMMUNITY CARE (HCC) - For Guard or Reservists during primary UTA weekends when there is no one else in the home to provide child care.

RESPITE CARE (RCC) - For the AD, Activated Guard or Reserve member who has a family member with special needs.

AIR FORCE AID SOCIETY (AFAS) FUNDED PROGRAM

Child Care for PCS - With a Certificate of Eligibility from AFRC, you may receive up to 20 hours of child care, per child, within 60 days of your PCS departure or arrival date.

CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

While our FCC providers may care for children with chronic health issues, developmental delays, and who are HIV-positive, medical screenings are required prior to care to ensure the provider is properly trained and equipped to provide these services.

PLEASE NOTE

All AF- and AFAS-funded child care programs are subject to funding and FCC provider space availability.
