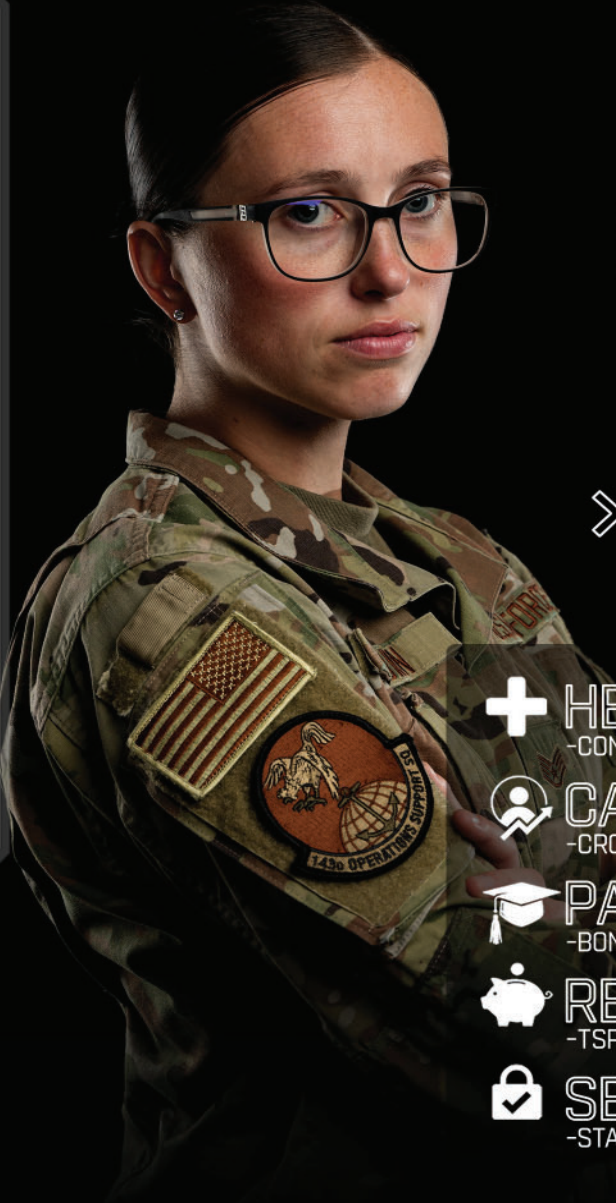

There's also a serious side to summer reading. Research has shown that reading over the summer prevents summer reading loss.

"Studies also indicate students who read recreationally outperformed those who don't. Students read more when they can choose materials based on their own interests," Kim Huskins Webb, Supervisory Librarian added. "Our library is committed to supporting lifelong learning and educational enrichment for all families."
